











BEFORE YOU START

- The key to beautiful tree is SHARP. Read instruction carefully before assembling and shaping the tree.
- Carton contains: 1 top section, 1 to 3 pole sections with brackets (panel holders), panels and tree stand.

GETTING STARTED

- 1. Take the metal stand out (Fig. 1).
- 2. Put end of pole tightly into the stand making sure that it is fixed into hole of the pan. Then, tighten the eyebolts as necessary (Fig. 2).

SHAPING AND ADDING PANELS

- 1. Shape panels by either
 - placing the branch in a panel holder which is at a comfortable level to work (Fig. 4) or
 - holding the branch in your hand with hooked end pointing down.

BEGIN WITH PANELS AT THE BOTTOM OF THE TREE AND WORK TOWARDS THE TOP

- 2. Fan out branches, one to the right, one to the left and one at the center. Starting from tips farthest from the pole and curving out from the pole. Tips at the center should be alternately placed so that they do not line up one behind the other (Fig. 3). Each set of panels should have a slightly upward curve when looked at from the side.
- 3. Twist the last tip around the end of stem to cover the wire (Fig.3).
- 4. As each panel is shaped, place the color-coded panel securely into appropriate panel holder (each color code for each layer, to place the color coded panels according to color codes marked on the end of each branch and each layer) (Fig. 4).
- 5. When all panels are shaped and put in their appropriate brackets, shape top section. Put down each row of branches in an even circular pattern. And then start from the bottom layer and further up. Carefully curve each tip upward for a natural look, and insert top securely into pole (Fig. 5).
- 6. Step back and take an overall look at the tree. Shift branches to fill any gaps. Slightly upsweep all branches tips for a uniform look. Your tree is now ready for you to decorate and enjoy (Fig. 6).
