B Pack Contents

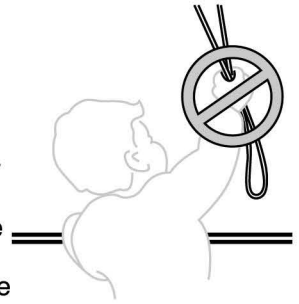
Minimum of:

1 x Blind 2 x Bracket 1 x Screw Pack
1x P Clip Safety Device (pre-fitted) 1x Chain



WARNING

Young children can be strangled by loops in pull cords, chains, tapes and inner cords that operate the product. To avoid strangulation and entanglement, keep cords out of reach of young children. Cords may become wrapped around a child's neck. Move beds, cots and furniture away from window covering cords. Do not tie cords together. Make sure cords do not twist and create a loop.



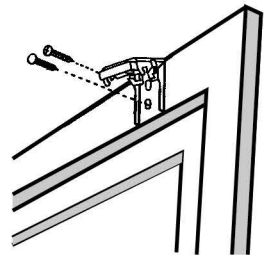
Persons in charge of children are ultimately responsible for following the safety instructions provided by the manufacturer and to use any safety device supplied.

C Fixing the Brackets

Top Mount

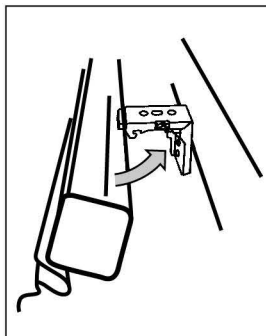
Place the blind bracket as shown, at least 8cm inside where the end of the head rail will rest. Mark screw holes then screw bracket. Repeat steps to install the second bracket at the other side, ensuring placement is equal on both sides. For larger blinds that require three or four brackets, the additional brackets should be evenly spaced between the outermost brackets.



D Fitting the Blind

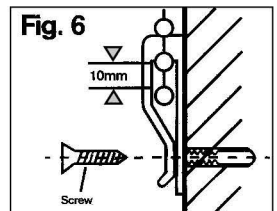
① Securing the Head Rail to the bracket:

1. Place head rail onto brackets so the lip at the front of the head rail is resting on the two hooks at the front of the bracket.
2. When the lip of the head rail is resting on the front of the brackets, push the back of the head rail up until you hear a click.



② Fitting the Safety Device

1. Pull the clip downward to take the slack out of the chain. At this point check the blind operates easily and the chain is not being over-tensioned.
2. Mark the position of the clip on the wall. Secure the clip in position using the screw provided. (see fig. 6).



Roman Blinds Important Note

We do not recommend that Roman Blinds are trimmed as the full effect of the blind may be lost

Actual Components may vary in detail from those shown
